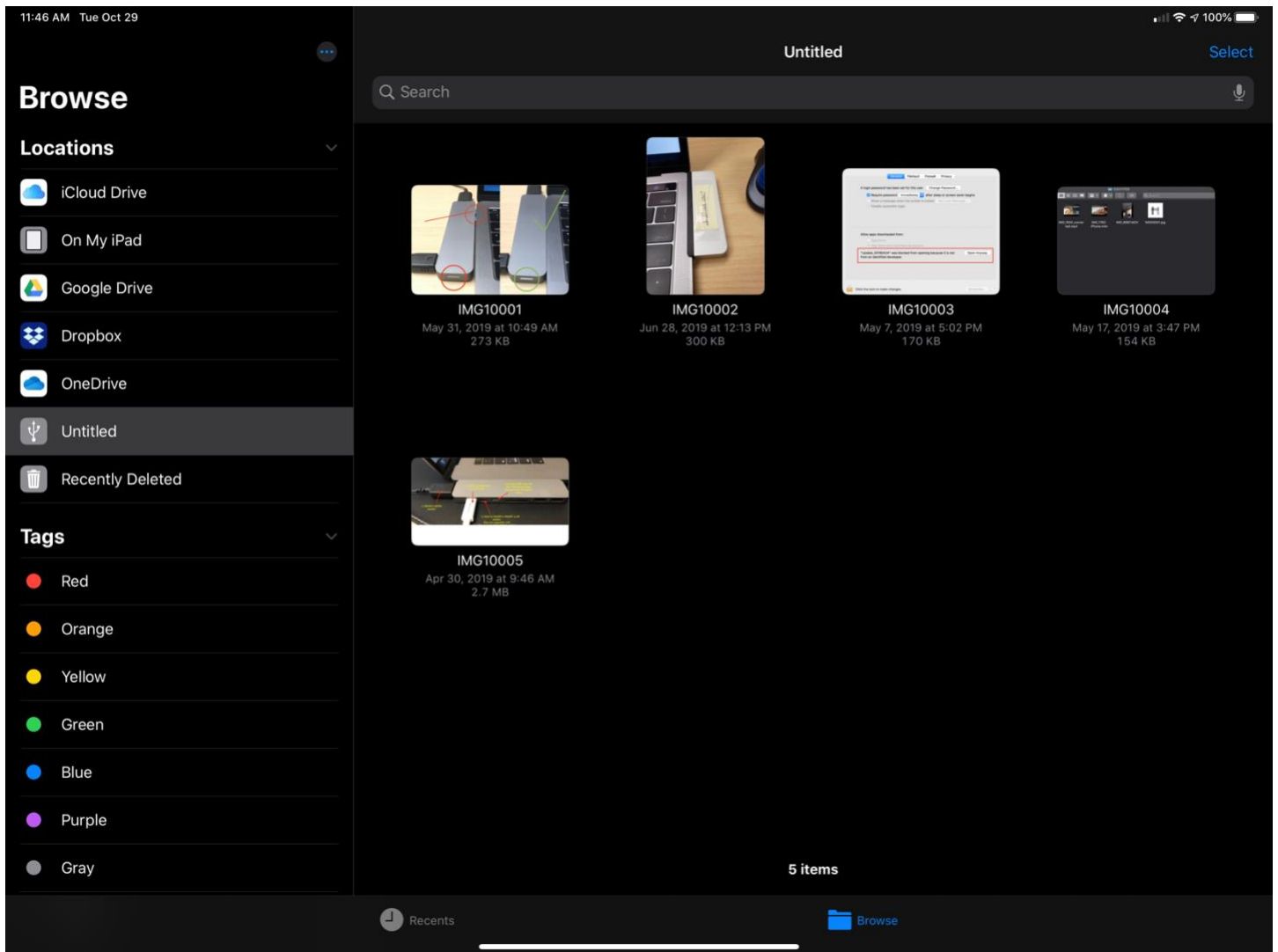


# iPad – Importing photos and videos from storage drive with iPadOS

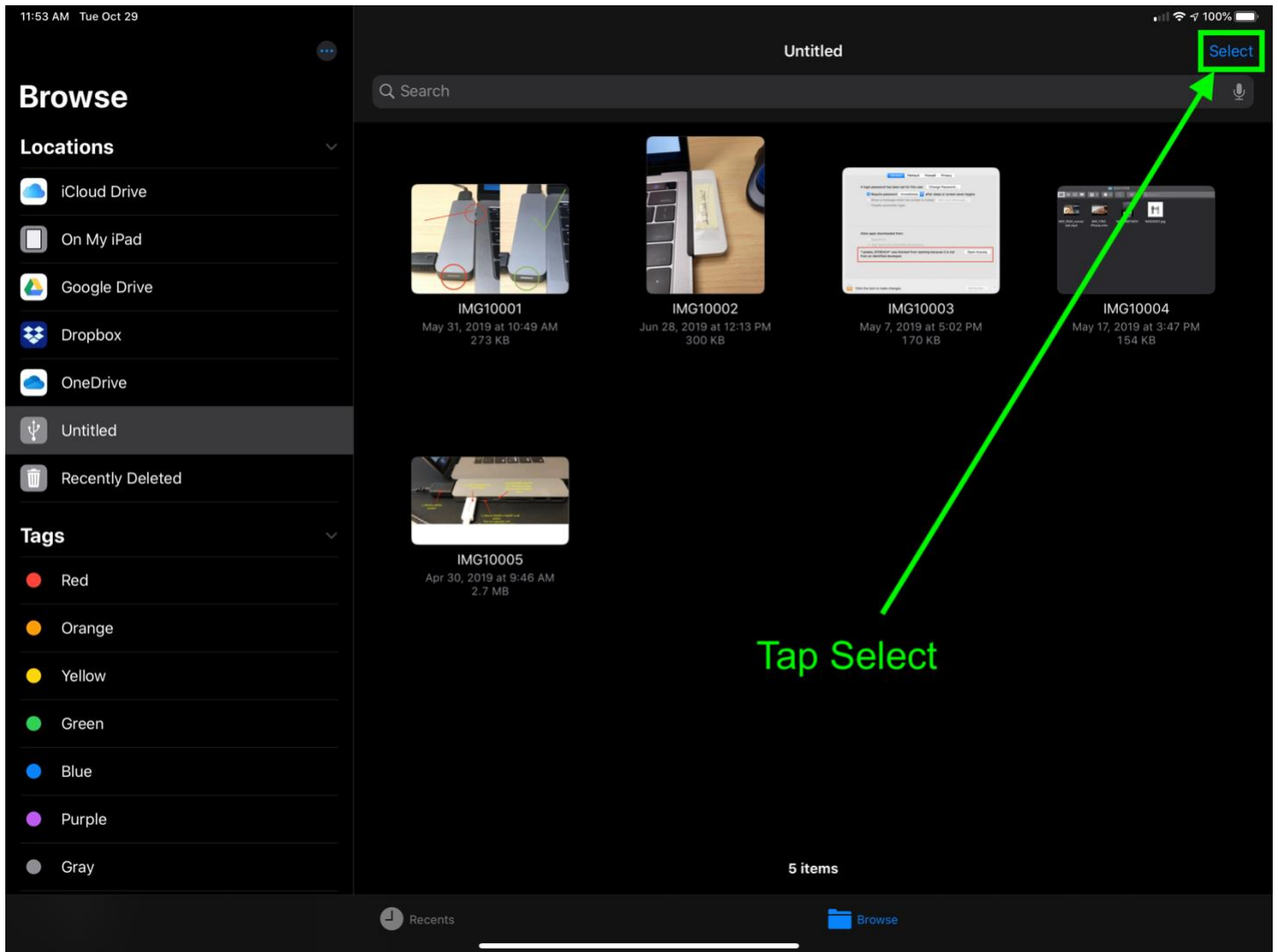

With the update to iPadOS, the HyperDrive for iPad Pro and the HyperDrive Power have become much more powerful tools for your uses. Here is how to import your photos and videos from external storage to your iPad:

Go to the Files app and select your storage device (you will see mine is called “Untitled”)
